

MAKE YOUR DAY (STEPS)

Students choose steps when their behavior interferes with the learning, safety, or well-being of others or their own safety or well-being. A student who fails to meet expectations but does not interfere with the learning, safety, or well-being of others, however, would not choose steps but would not earn full points. Steps are not "skipped in either direction except for an Automatic Step 4 or Step 5 or Shadowing. Shadowing is when another student responds to or interacts in any manner with student on steps... he/she has chosen to "shadow" or follow his/her fellow student through the steps. Choosing steps is only the business of the student making the choice... No other student should be allowed to become involved.
